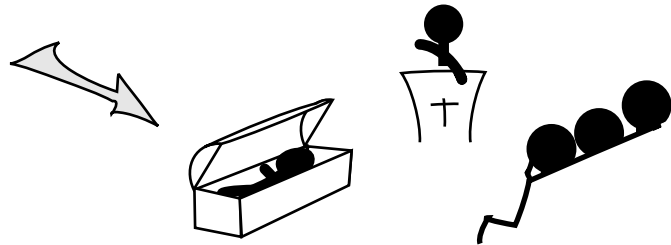


VIEWING

EMBALMING

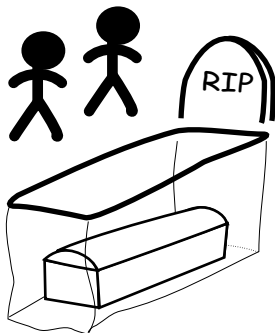
During embalming, an **undertaker** replaces blood with embalming fluid at a funeral home.
